Announcement of Registration for November 2026 Examinations

The November 2026 Examinations will be administered in a **center-based online format**.

The timetable for the November 2026 Examinations, scheduled from **24 October 2026 to 4 November 2026**, is available [Click here](#).

1. Please note the following important details:

- Online registration commences on **Tuesday, 4 August 2026 at 3:00 p.m.**
- Registration without a late fee closes on **Thursday, 17 September 2026 at 3:00 p.m.**
- Registration with a late fee closes on **Thursday, 24 September 2026 at 3:00 p.m.**
- Hall tickets will be available for download through the member login by **15 October 2026 at 6:00 p.m.** No hard copy of the hall ticket will be issued.
- The examination payment receipt will be available for download under the **"Examination"** tab upon successful registration. No hard copy of the payment receipt will be issued.

2. Examination Registration Steps:

- Log in to your member account using your **Login ID** and **Password**. ([Click here to login](#).)
- Navigate to **Examination** → **Exam Registration Form**.
- Select your preferred examination centre from the drop-down list.
- Select the subject(s) you wish to appear for from the drop-down list.

Note: Only the subjects for which you have purchased the study material will be displayed. You may register for multiple subjects in the same examination session, provided they are not scheduled on the same date and at the same time.

- Review the application carefully and proceed with the payment of the examination fees.
- Upon successful payment, you will be redirected to the registration confirmation page.

3. Additional Information:



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- **Registration for Additional Subject(s):** Candidates wishing to register for additional subject(s) are required to follow the examination registration process outlined above.
- **Change of Examination Centre:** Candidates may change their examination centre on or before 17 September 2026 up to 3:00 p.m. through Examination → Change Centre.
- **Overseas Examination Centres:** The November 2026 Actuarial Examinations will be conducted only at examination centres in India.
- **Mock Examination:** The Institute will conduct mock examination(s) for all registered candidates. The mock examination will enable candidates to verify that their systems meet the prescribed technical requirements and familiarise themselves with the examination software and process. Candidates are strongly advised to appear for the mock examination(s) for each registered subject to avoid any last-minute technical issues. Details of the mock examination schedule will be communicated after the registration process closes.

The Student Guide for the November 2026 Actuarial Examinations will be issued separately and will contain detailed instructions on the examination process.
