

Overseas examination centres – November 2026

Students who wish to appear for the **November 2026 Actuarial Examination from an overseas centre**, other than **Russia, Cuba, Iran, North Korea, Sudan and Syria**, may submit their request through their respective **Member Login**.

Students must provide the following details/documents to facilitate the arrangement of an overseas examination centre:

Sr. No.	Required details/documents
1	Name of the Fellow Member proposed to supervise/invigilate the examination
2	Name of the Actuarial Body/Institute with which the Fellow Member is associated
3	Membership/Fellowship Number of the Fellow Member
4	Email ID and contact number of the Fellow Member
5	Signed declaration by the Fellow Member in the format prescribed by IAI
6	Examination centre location, with photographs and complete address
7	Copy of a valid passport
8	Copy of a valid visa / residence permit / work permit / student visa / permanent residency document
9	Proof of overseas residential address issued within the last three months, such as a utility bill, bank statement, lease agreement or government correspondence
10	Employment letter, where applicable, confirming overseas employment
11	Student enrolment letter, where applicable, confirming overseas education
12	Candidate self-declaration confirming physical presence outside India throughout the examination period and the authenticity of the submitted information/documents

Note:

1. The **Overseas Examination Centre Request Form** will be available from **8 September 2026 at 3:00 p.m.**
2. Examination fees remain unchanged.
3. The examination will be conducted strictly as per **Indian Standard Time (IST)**.
4. Students must arrange the hardware and software required for the respective examination.
