## Announcement on Modification in ACET Examination Eligibility Criteria for June 2021 examination

This is with reference to the Actuarial Common Entrance Test (ACET) Registration Eligibility Criteria for June 2021 examination.

Current Eligibility Criteria for ACET Examination Registration states as under;

"Students who have appeared or have passed the 10+2 examination or an equivalent examination at the time of registering for ACET."

Due to prevailing pandemic of COVID19, the 10 + 2 examinations has been delayed and missed the normal schedule. In view of this, students who would appear in 10 + 2 examinations may not fulfil the eligibility criteria to register and appear for ACET Examination scheduled by the Institute

In order to balance the well-being and desire of many students to pursue the actuarial studies, as a special case, Institute has modified its eligibility criteria for ACET Examination Registration for June 2021 examination as under;

## "Students who have passed 10+1 standard examination or equivalent examination shall be eligible to register and appear for the ACET Examination."

It may be noted that students who passed ACET examination will be able to get the admission for the Student Membership of Institute of Actuaries of India based on passing 10+2 examination

Note:

ACET result is valid for 3 years from the date of declaration of the exam result for taking student membership of the Institute.
